

In Case of an Emergency

In the event of an incident at the construction site or pipeline, a warning alarm will sound

Warning Alarms

In the event of an incident one or more of the following alarms will be heard:

- Minor event – three short sounds
- Serious event – one long sound
- Vehicle mounted speakers

Communication of the details of the nature of the emergency will be provided by EPL staff and / or contractors.
Communication of actions e.g. evacuation will be given.

If you notice an incident or are concerned

- [Move yourself and others away from the dangerous area](#)
- [Do not enter the area of danger](#)
- Contact the EPL or METKA if a minor incident
- Contact third party emergency services – if a major incident
